1. Colours

Primary colours

Are the colours that are used most frequently, as background colour and type.

Accent colours


Are used to highlight certain elements.

Secondary colours

Are used the least. They are useful when there's a need for greater colour variations, for example when creating illustrations, maps or infographics.




Below are a few examples of how the colours can be used.


Example 1 is the preferred use of background colour, type colour and accent colours.

Examples 2 and 3 provide alternatives when greater variation is needed.


